- Students will be expected to display appropriate behavior. **Failure to do so may result in suspension and/or removal from camp without a refund.** The summer program will adhere to the standards of student conduct for Albemarle County Public Schools available by visiting: <http://www2.k12albemarle.org/acps/students/Pages/default.aspx>.
- Students involved in confrontations involving weapons and/or physical contact will be removed from the summer program and will not receive a refund.
- A student who possesses, uses, or is under the influence of a drug, narcotic, tobacco product, or alcoholic beverage will be removed from the summer program and will not receive a refund.
- Personal stereo players, video games or any other electronic devices are prohibited.
- A student's dress may not interfere with classroom activities nor contribute to the creation of a disturbance. The *Extreme* Journey Camp t-shirt and shoes must be worn every day. Extra camp t-shirts may be purchased for \$15 each.
- Students cannot be dropped off in the morning until a camp instructor has arrived. They must be checked in and out by a junior counselor every day. Parents are expected to pick students up promptly at the end of each day's session.
- This signed registration form gives parental permission for a student's participation in course field trips. Parents will be informed of such field trips in advance. Fees may apply for off-site meals.
- The *Extreme* Journey Summer Camp requires a variety of vigorous activity, especially on trip days. We will be hiking, biking, marching, and canoeing our way through several historic sites. Students are expected to be aware of the physical challenges they will face before registration is complete.
